

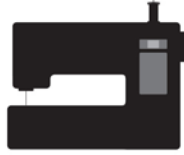

**Summerville’s Annual Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony.** Join the Town of Summerville and the Summerville Garden Club for the Annual Christmas Tree Lighting in Hutchinson Square on **Tuesday, December 6, 5:00–7:30pm.** We will have food vendors with items available for purchase, a few free holiday-themed activities for kids as well as free cookies from Summerville DREAM. The musical entertainment will kick-off at 6:00pm in front of Town Hall. The Tree Lighting is scheduled for approximately 7:00pm. Little Main St. and W. Richardson Ave. between Main St. and Short Central will be closed to traffic for the safety of event goers. This is a rain or shine event.

**The Annual Christmas Parade.** Sponsored by Summerville DREAM, a free, public event. Traditionally, the parade is one of the largest in the state, featuring nearly 3,000 participants with an overwhelming spectatorship of 25,000. The Parade sports an annual theme, in which the participants’ floats are judged, based on originality, creativity, and overall effort. Community members are encouraged to promote their organization, school or business to help celebrate the holiday. Spread Christmas cheer by dressing in holiday costume, handing out candy, etc.-only participants in the holiday spirit will be allowed to take part in the procession. **Parade starts: Sunday, December 11 at 2pm.**

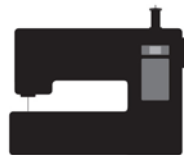
