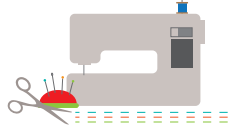

These 6 intermediate classes continue the quilting journey. This session began in January. The next one will begin in May offering daytime and evening classes.

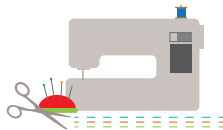

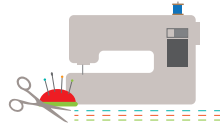


Sewing without Sue

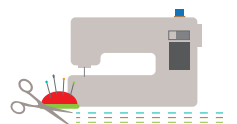
