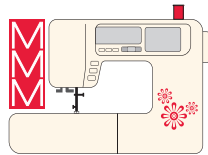

- Thread - types, cross wound vs. stacked, spool types, using a thread stand
- Needles; bobbins/bobbin types and sizes
- Tension (upper and lower) (how it works and when to adjust)
- Cleaning (above the needle/below the needle, inside and out)
- Oiling; types of oil to use and not to use; where to oil is needed
- Servicing - when and how often; what servicing by me includes
- Show and tell - illustrations of sewing machine problems and causes; questions and/or problems.
